## The 1994 Races

Thank you for taking part in the largest and most popular long distance running and walking relays in the world. There are no other events in existence which rival the excitement and emotion of the Nationwide Insurance Hood To Coast and Portland To Coast Relays. We hope this year was one of your most memorable.

It took a lot of hard work and dedication on the part of the Race Committee and the more than two thousand volunteers to make this event a success for you. All of the teams who provided the races' terrific volunteers deserve a huge thank you from all of us. The volunteers made the event. They were bright, alert and cheerful and did their best to protect and assist you on the roads.

We're sure you'll agree, this year's race witnessed the smoothest traffic flow and the least congestion along the course in recent years' memory. Thank you, Forrest Abel, for the new starting wave concept which featured the spreading of start waves and the mid-morning start of the race at Timberline. For those late finishing teams in Hood To Coast.....rest assured, the last leg through Gearhart will be eliminated in 1995.

Nearly 11,000 runners and walkers took to the roads in near-perfect sunny conditions for the thirteenth running of this classic. Only you, the veterans of this year's competition, will ever truly comprehend the magic that unfolded for you during those brief two days in August. Remember the serenity of running or walking late at night under moonlit skies, the electricity in the air at the exchange points, the flow of adrenalin that fought to overcome the physical fatigue and lack of sleep, the words of encouragement from teammates as you struggle to complete your final leg and the warm embraces awaiting you, the thrill of hearing the crowd cheering as you

moved onto the sand and approached the Finish. Yes, these are special memories that will be yours forever.

## Hood To Coast

A national running publication once described the Nationwide Insurance Hood To Coast Relay as "the Mother of all Relays". This event founded the popularity of relays across the country and has always served as the benchmark for other relays to compare themselves against. Whether you are a novice, middle of the pack, or world-class elite runner, the feeling is the same.....there is no greater competitive and team camaraderie event in the world.

At the elite men's end of the spectrum, we saw the two largest athletic shoe titans in the world, Nike and Adidas, send wave after wave of world-class runners at each other. Like two great heavyweight boxers, they traded blows relentlessly for over 15 continuous hours. They traded the lead back and forth until two legs remained. At that point TEAM NIKE MAMBU BADDU overtook ADIDAS ROLLING THUNDER for the final time. Both teams crushed the course record. Defending their 1993 championship, Nike's record time of 15:56:54 was an unbelievable pace of 5:00 per mile. Nike team captain, Alberto Salazar, was quoted afterwards as saying "this was the single greatest athletic achievement and experience in my life."

Not to be upstaged by the men, the Women's Open competition this year witnessed the deepest and greatest field ever assembled in our event's history. By mid-race, two teams emerged from this talented pack, FAST TWITCH WOMEN and course record holder CHICKS THAT CRANK. The world-class roster, captained by Laura Edmark, ultimately proved to be too formidable for the CHICKS THAT CRANK. Both teams obliterated the existing course record. FAST TWITCH WOMEN's winning time of 20:07:10 (6:19 per mile) was 33:00 under the old record

and a mere 11:00 ahead of the CHICKS. Perennial champions during the first nine years of Hood To Coast, the COASTLINE CRUISERS made a reunion appearance in this year's competition. Although they finished in third place overall, the CRUISERS goal and primary accomplishment was that they raised over \$10,000 for Reach To Recovery, a volunteer organization that serves breast cancer victims.

There were many other highlights within this year's race. Two additional course records also fell. RUNNING WITH WOODIE broke the Men's SubmasterS record with a time of 17:26:38; BRITISH AIRWAYS claimed the Men's Corporate record in 19:13:22. Many of you probably saw the film crew and team from Japan. They produced a 90 minute documentary of the race which was recently aired on national Japanese television. Finishing in sixth place in Men's Corporate, Runner's World magazine's team made a strong debut showing. Watch for race-related articles in the December issue. Of course, we will never cease to marvel over the third successful finish by the two-man, father-son team, THE AXMEN COMETH. Stacey and Larry Axmaker.....whew!

## Portland To Coast Run

Thirty-seven Portland To Coast Run teams began in Waterfront Park and covered over 122 miles of Hood To Coast's race course. Many participants find this event a welcome relief to the intensity and magnitude of Hood To Coast. The fact that each person only has to cover two legs makes it a popular choice of the young as well as those who find Hood To Coast too physically demanding.

The top two teams in this year's race were both made up of high school boys along with their coaches. A team from Rainier High School, the RAINIER MEN, claimed the Portland To Coast championship with a time of 13:46:59; 6:44 per mile pace.

The 1995 race will receive a strong emphasis upon the high school competitive categories. It is hoped that the high school races can become a major championship for high school cross country teams throughout Oregon and Washington. We are also exploring the possibility of establishing a college scholarship for Oregon's top male and female track athletes.

## Portland To Coast Walk

The Portland To Coast Walk has been growing significantly in both size and popularity. This year's field of 120 teams was nearly twice the size of 1993's. The

message that we receive from this is that not only is the sport of walking growing, but Portland To Coast is meeting the desires and needs of the Walk community. We have worked very hard through our race committees' efforts and the opinion surveys which we have circulated to our participants to design an event which meets your greatest expectations. Our goal is to create the premier walking event and adventure in the country. We are committed to making this event be to the walk community what Hood To Coast is to the running community.

Three new masters categories were added to Portland To Coast this year. This year's overall competition was highlighted by a

second consecutive victory by RACE-WALKERS NORTHWEST. This Mixed Masters team's winning time of 22:24:26 breaks down to an average pace of 10:58 per mile. Two course records were also broken. ROLLING COASTERS eclipsed the Men's Walking record with a time of 24:24:01 and TOO ABREAST broke their own Women's Walking record in 23:19:51.

The walk committee did a great job of tightening up the walk-only rules and applying uniform enforcement of them. We've heard from this year's participants and they've told us that they appreciated the additional volunteer support and bathrooms along the course. We'll continue to refine your event.

I know that running or walking a road race, regardless of the distance, is a potentially hazardous activity. I should not enter and participate unless I am medically able and properly trained. I agree to abide by any decision of a race official relative to my ability to safely complete this road race and I further agree that race officials may authorize necessary emergency treatment for me. I also understand that police protection will not be provided, and both vehicle traffic and spectators will be present along the course and I assume the risk of running under such conditions. I further assume any and all other risks associated with participating in the 1995 HOOD TO COAST RELAY and PORTLAND TO COAST RELAYS (hereinafter "the event") including, but not limited to illness, traveling to and from the event, falls, contact with spectators or other participants, the effects of the weather (including temperature extremes and humidity) and the surface condition of the roads, all such risks being known and appreciated by me. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of the acceptance of my entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, my executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and waive, release and discharge Race Director Robert L. Foola, Jr., Foola Sports Productions, Inc., The Hood To Coast Relay, the City of Portland, race officials, volunteers and any and all other sponsors, suppliers, agents, independent contractors, employees and any other personnel in any way assisting or connected with this running event from any and all claims or liability of any kind or nature whatsoever arising out of my participation in this event, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or parties named in this waiver.

## Entry Requirements

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** June 30, 1995 or when the limit on the field is reached. The limit is usually reached long before this deadline.

**TO REGISTER:** Teams may register, initially, with as few as one member (their team captain) so as to secure their place in the race. The additional people may be added at no extra cost until June 1, 1995.

**COURSE AND FINISH CLOSURE:** The Finish Area will CLOSE AUGUST 26, SATURDAY EVENING AT 12:00 AM. Each Exchange Point along the race course will close on the appropriate closure schedule which will prevent any team from finishing the race after midnight.

**VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS:** All teams in both races must provide 3 *NON-TEAM MEMBER VOLUNTEERS* for the races. Excluded from this requirement are teams which have *EVERY* team member living 50 or more miles from downtown Portland (Salem, McMinnville and Longview-Kelso are considered within 50 miles). See Volunteer Section of this flyer.

**T-SHIRT SELECTIONS:** All members of a team who submit their *individual* applications with T-shirt size indicated *PRIOR TO JUNE 1* are guaranteed to receive their desired size of shirt prior to the race. Those individuals who submit these forms later than June 1 will only be allowed to select from the shirts and sizes remaining.

## Seeding

The Start Times for all teams will be based upon the submitted "10K Potential" (Run) or "Min/Mile" (Walk) times of each team's members. This time should represent as close as possible your *potential on August 26*. The seeding procedure this year will place a mixture of slow, medium and fast teams in every start wave throughout the race. There is no way to second guess what start wave your team will start within. No Starting Time requests will be accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

## Substitutions

Substitutions and Additions must be submitted on a copy of the "**ENTRY OR SUBSTITUTION FORM**" within this race flyer. The name of the person being dropped and all pertinent information for the new person must be noted on the Substitution form. Failure to submit the

appropriate form and fee for *Substitutions and Additions* will result in the *team's disqualification*. Subs-Adds WILL NOT be accepted over the phone. They must be mailed to the Race Mailing Address or delivered to the Start Area on race day.

### UNTIL JUNE 1, 1995:

If your team did not register all 12 of its members initially, you may register *ADDITIONS* at *NO COST* until June 1. For **\$5.00 per person**, *SUBSTITUTIONS* may be made until June 1.

### FROM JUNE 2 THROUGH AUGUST 23:

Additions and Substitutions may be made for **\$10.00 per person** until August 23.

### AUGUST 24 AND 25:

Additions and Substitutions must have an "Entry-Sub Form" and **\$15.00 per person** submitted to the Check-In Area at the race Start Area of each race on August 26.

## Race Packets

**TEAM HANDBOOKS:** All teams which have registered by May 25 will have their Handbooks mailed to them by *June 1*. These handbooks will contain race rules and instructions, course maps, and Volunteer information and registration forms. Teams which register later than May 25 will have their handbooks mailed to them within two weeks of acceptance of entry.

**START TIMES:** Start times will be included within the Race Packets for Portland-area teams in all three races at **PACKET PICK-UP** on August 5. "Out-of-town" teams will have Start times mailed to them on August 2.

**RACE PACKETS:** Race packets will contain Start Times, T-shirts, Race Numbers, Scoring Sheets, Volunteer Job Assignments and Descriptions and Race Vehicle Signs. Wrist Wraps for *ALL* teams will be picked up at the **RACE START**.

Race Packets for teams which have *at least one* member living within 50 miles of Portland may be picked up on August 5 at the Packet Pick-Up at the *parking structure adjacent to Emanuel Medical Office Building, on N. Graham Street, Portland*. Packets not picked up on August 5 will *ONLY* be available again at the Start Area on race day or at the HTC Office. These teams may receive their Volunteer Job Assignments by phoning the Race Phone at 227-1371. Race Packets for teams lo-

cated further than 50 miles from Portland will be available at the Race Start on August 24.

## The Course

**HOOD TO COAST:** The 191 mile course consists of 36 running legs varying in length from 4 to 6 miles. The **TEAM HANDBOOK**, which each team receives, contains detailed maps and written descriptions of each leg on the course. Maximum number of members on a team is 12. All members of a team are to run in successive order.

**PORTLAND TO COAST:** Same as above except 122 mile course consists of 24 running or walking legs varying in length from 4 to 6 miles. Maximum number of members on a team is 12.

For teams looking for people to fill the last few spots on their team rosters and individuals looking for a team to compete on, we are providing a matching service. **MIXED CATEGORIES:** Teams with 12 members are to have a min. of 6 women. Teams with 10-11 members are to have a minimum of 5 women. Teams with 8-9 members are to have a minimum of 4 women. Teams with less than the required number of women for mixed categories will become men's categories. Any team made up of 1-5 men and the rest women will be classified within the mixed categories.

**ELITE MEN CATEGORY:** This special category has been formed for all teams which have an "Anticipated Finish Time" of under 18 hours.

## ■ Emergencies

All participants must clearly understand that **THERE WILL NOT BE ANY TRAFFIC OR POLICE MONITORS TO PROTECT THEM FROM VEHICULAR TRAFFIC** along the course. Great care must be exercised at all times by participants and team vehicles. Participants are to move along the left shoulder or sidewalk of the road at all times and obey all traffic signals. Failure to heed signals may result in disqualification.

**EACH TEAM MUST PROVIDE ITS OWN FLUID AND OTHER AID.** There will be several toilets available at every Exchange Point along the course. Dial 911 for emergency medical aid. Each team is limited to 2 vehicles, preferably vans. **NO MOTOR HOMES** (6'-6" or wider) or **LIMOUSINES.**

## ■ Equipment

Each team **MUST HAVE TWO REFLECTIVE SAFETY VESTS AND TWO FLASH-LIGHTS** and must present these for inspection at the Start Area of each race. Upon receiving check-in approval, each team will be given an official Wrist Wrap.

## ■ Volunteers

It will be **MANDATORY THAT EVERY TEAM PROVIDE 3 VOLUNTEERS, 16 YEARS OR OLDER**, for the Race as a requirement of entry. This requirement does not apply for teams which have EVERY member living over 50 miles from downtown Portland (Salem, McMinnville and Longview-Kelso are considered within 50 miles). **FAILURE TO FULFILL THIS REQUIREMENT WILL RESULT IN DQ.**

Teams, which register prior to May 25, will have a "Team Handbook" mailed to them by June 1. Teams which register after that date will have these handbooks sent to them within two weeks of acceptance of their entry. Jobs and job locations will be given to teams registering volunteers on a first-come, first-served basis. The Volunteer Registration form for ALL 3 of a team's required volunteers must be **RECEIVED BY US NO LATER THAN JULY 14.**

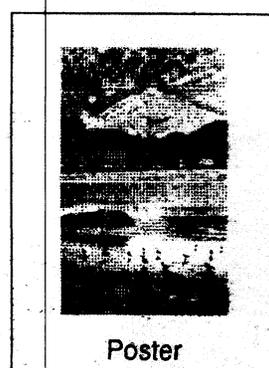
